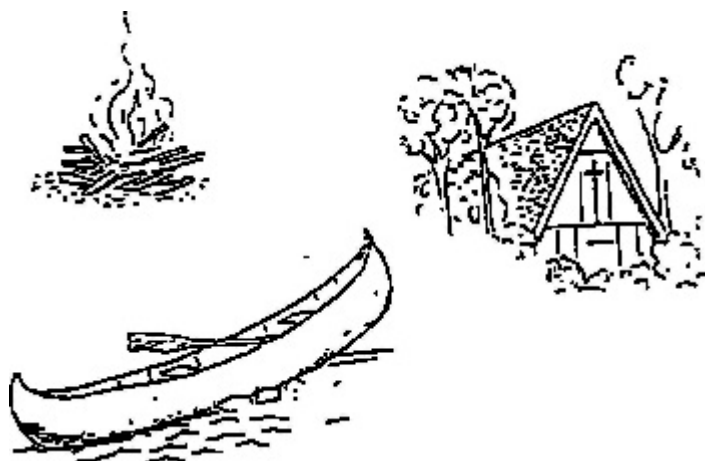

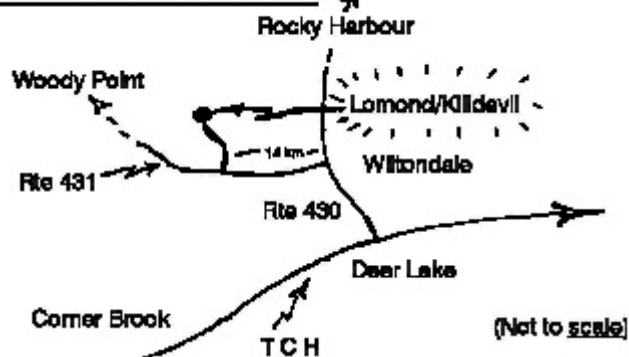


Killdevil Camp

Operated by the Anglican Diocese of Western Newfoundland

Killdevil Camp is located at Lomond in the **Gros Morne National Park**. Directly across East Arm, Bonne Bay, from the campsite is Killdevil Mountain, part of the Long Range Mountains from which the camp takes its name. The mountain was given the name long ago when it was said that "it would kill any poor devil who tried to climb it". The camp can accommodate up to 150 campers in heated cabins with modern facilities.

TELEPHONE: There is a phone at camp - **Telephone #: 1-709-636-2267.** The phone is used by camp leaders only and for emergency purposes. Personal calls to campers are not encouraged but if parents must call, they must speak to the director.

Campers **should not** have any money on them as all necessities are covered by fees. Should campers need to carry money with them, it should be handed in to staff for safe keeping at the time of registration. Killdevil Camp is not responsible for lost or stolen items.

CAMP FEE: includes board and lodging, canteen in the amount of **\$155.00 + \$20.15 HST for a total of \$175.15** which is to be sent along with the application. In case of refund, PRIOR TO START OF CAMP, all but \$15.00 for administration costs will be refunded. There may be an extra cost of \$10.00 for an off-site trip and \$5.00 for a group photograph (8x10) which will be collected at the beginning of camp. A \$5.00 donation to the Camp Chapel, St. Andrew's Church, is recommended as well. **There will be no refund of registration fee after the beginning of camp.**

T-Shirts: \$12.00; Child's: \$10.00; Sweatshirts: \$22.00; Child's: \$18.00; Caps: \$10.00 Hoodies: Adult's: \$32.00; (All prices subject to change)
