



Killdevil Camp

Operated by the Anglican Diocese of Western Newfoundland Killdevil Camp is located at Lomond in the Gros Morne National Park. Directly across East Arm, Bonne Bay, from the campsite is Killdevil Mountain, part of the Long Range Mountains from which the camp takes its name. The mountain was given the name long ago when it was said that "it would kill any poor devil who tried to climb it". The camp can accommodate up to 150 campers in heated cabins with modern facilities.
